To empower women and make India a develop country through mobilizing community and skill development programs

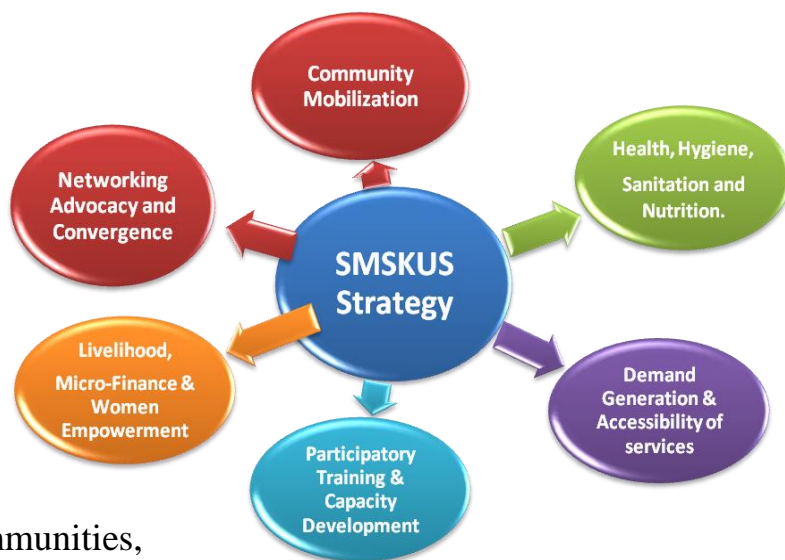

Major activities conducted during past financial year 2019-20-

Quarter -1 (April- June, 2019)

1. Conducted vocational training program in Khandwa district to developed skill of women and youths for livelihood (regular program organized round the year from April 2019 to March, 2020). More than 75 participants were benefited through the training course
2. SMSKUS organized Swatchata awareness events on every week in different park of Ujjain city to create awareness among the people to keep their surrounding neat and clean, liquid and solid west management, avoid plastic for better environment of town and health of people. Almost 2000 people get aware through the events.
3. Base line Survey were conducted to assess the life and health status of Banchda community women under the Jabali Yogjna of DWCD of Neemach district.
4. International Labor Day was celebrated on 1st May to aware the unorganized labors on their rights.
5. As part of Cultural program, organized play to celebrate International Dance day in Ujjain city. More than 60 people were observed the event.
6. Health Checkup camp were organized in Nalkheda Block and nearly 60 community member get benefited



7. International Nasha mukti divas to create awareness among general population. 80 people participated in the program.

8. Yoga camp organized on the occasion of **21st June, World Yoga Day** in Ujjain City to create awareness among the general population on yoga and health for healthy life. Nearly 30 people participated in the event.

Quarter -2 (July- Sep 2019)

1. A motivational program was organized in Bherugarh, Ujjain to encourage and aware Self Help Group members on new upcoming livelihood schemes of government. Nearly 90 SHG members were participated in the program.

2. Awareness program (Rally) was organized in Nanakhed area Ujjain on women safety at work place and during travel time as well. Mostly 60 women were oriented on the topic.



3. SMSKUS also organized a consumer awareness program on the occasion of Consumer Day at Shanti Nagar, Ujjain and nearly 90 people were participated in the event.

4. Udaypur unit of SMSKUS were conducted Pradhan Mantri VAN Dhan Vikas Kendra Yojna with the support of Ministry OF Tribal Affairs, GoI

through Rajasthan Kshatriya Development Samiti in the Tehseel of Som and Jharold of district Udaipur, Rajasthan. Under the program 30 SHGs were formed involving 300 tribal community women and also federation of these SHGs is also constituted. This Federation members will help in making Ayurvedice medicines from forest produces in the guidance of AYUSH medical practitioners.

8. Event organized in Ujjain to create awareness on Domestic Violence and its adverse effects on women health, growth of family and society as well. Nearly 80 participants were participated in the event.

9. Organized program on Water and Sanitation (WASH) in Village Chandesri, Ujjain to create awareness among general community. Nearly 30 people were participated in the program.



10. Plantation event organized in Ujjain city by SMSKUS to protect the environment and promote green and clean Ujjain. Nearly 30 people were participated in the event.

11. SMSKU has organized rally against Acid Attack incident in Nalkheda to aware the community on this serious matter. More than 70 people were participated in this rally.

Quarter -4 (Jan-March, 2020) –

1. Throughout the year, SMSKUS conducted the Skill Development Program for Miner prisoners in the jubilance jail of Ujjain. 29 Prisoners were got trained on Matikala, Garments and handicraft etc.
2. Organization distributed the blankets to old age, poor and needy ones to protect them from cold in Ujjain City. 22 persons get benefited from this charity activity.

3. Organized campaign events to create awareness among general population on side effect of use of tobacco on health. This program was organized in Hemukhedi, Ujjain and 45 people took participation.
4. Organized camp in Mother Teresa Ashram, Ujjain to help and support for disabled. 72 people were benefited from the camp.
5. NGO has organized an event on Vishwa Rangmanch Day to create awareness on art and craft in community. 110 persons available in the event.
6. A Cultural Program also organized in Nanakheda, Ujjain and 230 peoples were attended this event.
7. Republic day program organized in Bal Samprekshan Grah, Ujjain. 50 persons were participated in the program.
8. Awareness program were organized on HIV/ AIDS control and preventions at Vikram Kirti Mandir, Ujjain and nearly people attended this.
9. Sant Ravidas Jayanti was celebrated by organization in Ujjain on 11th February, 2020 and nearly 60 people were participated in the event.
10. Handicapped people camp were organized in Ujjain to motivate and aware them on different new government scheme and benefits. More than 30 handicapped personals were attended the program.
11. SMSKUS also supported Divyang Marriage event organized in Ujjain in terms of providing wedding dress to 121 brides.
12. We have organized awareness program on use of Sanitary Napkin in women in Ujjain and also distributed 60 napkins to needy women from weaker sections.



13. Organized general health awareness and checkup program focusing on preventions from different seasonal disease, Ujjain. Nearly 70 people were benefited through the program.



14. World women's day was celebrated by SMSKUS on 8th March, 2020 at Nalkheda and nearly 60 women were participated in the event. Motivational guest speakers

shared their views on tools of women empowerment and self dependency in the program.



15. Under the Corona (Covid-19) Global Pandemic, SMSKUS provided support to poor, disabled, labors, children since last week of March, 2020 through providing food and mask to poor and needy people in Ujjain city.
